Because cervical cancer affects women of all ages, prevention should begin as early as the pre-teen years and continue throughout life. Health plans or public aid programs often cover the costs.

Illinois has the fifth highest rate of cervical cancer in the nation, and African-American women are 50 percent more likely than white women to be among the 4,000 women who die from this cancer each year.
